DESIGN RESPONSIBILITY REWARDED

Castleway Construction's commitment to the environment has been rewarded with two peer group awards. Its work on the new and contemporary design for Bishop Wordsworth's new 6th form building has been granted the double accolade of become the first school to achieve the Secured by Design police approved award in Wiltshire and also receiving a 'Very Good' rating under the industries BREEAM scheme.

To achieve the award, the building has been designed and built in conjunction with the police backed scheme, which has ensured that the design of the building along with the hardware such as doors, windows and locks have conformed to standards that have undergone rigorous testing in terms of crime prevention and security.

Architectural liaison officer for Wiltshire Police, Claire Rooney said "we have all sorts of new developments apply for Secured by Design, but this is the first school building. Its great to see that staff at the school have been mindful of issues such as security and that they have fully committed to this project along with the architect and contractor to achieve accreditation"

Castleway Construction has also sought and achieved Secured by Design accreditation on the housing development just completed on the site of the old Conquered Moon public house site on Bemerton Heath.
